

HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES







CLEANING & SANITIZING

The health and safety of our students is our chief priority. Over the last several weeks, our teachers and administrative staff have been working tirelessly to design a rigorous cleaning and sanitization process that ensures our students remain as protected as possible while on campus. Our enhanced efforts include:

- High-touch surfaces around campus will be cleaned throughout the day, including doors, desktops, light switches, handrails, water bottle filling stations, bathroom sinks and toilets, chairs, and benches.
- Hand sanitizers are in all classrooms and stations have been added throughout the public areas of the school.
- The school will provide sanitizing wipes for teachers to use in the classroom.
- Nightly cleaning crews will disinfect surfaces and regular detailed cleaning of all the surfaces in classrooms and hallways will occur.
- All of our AC units have outdoor fresh air intakes.
- Students are encouraged to bring a reusable water bottle from home.



HEALTH & SAFETY PROCEDURES

Students in grades K-5 are encouraged to wear a mask upon entering the school. Students in grades 6-12 must wear a mask per Trinity College policy.

- Masks are encouraged but not required for students in preschool.
- Any student or teacher observed as having symptoms of a communicable disease will be removed from the classroom and isolated until a parent or guardian can pick them up.
- When a student has a medical condition that prevents them from wearing a mask, the student will be physically distanced from others.



ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE PROCEDURES

The Genesis Schools have created updated student arrival and departure procedures to ensure everyone entering the building remains safe.

Arrival

We will continue to use our standard staggered arrival procedures.

- All students will have their body temperature taken by contactless thermometer prior to exiting their vehicle. Students with a body temperature that exceeds 100.4 will not be permitted to enter the school.
- Students participating in before-care will be dropped off by parents at the car loop.

Departure

• Students will remain on the benches until their parents arrive through the car loop. They will be called to exit directly to their vehicle.



OPERATIONAL DETAILS

In anticipation of returning to on-campus learning in August, we have modified our procedures as follows:

- Only students and staff are permitted to enter The Genesis Schools.
- All students will report to their classrooms each morning using safe physical distancing as much as possible.
- To assist with school safety operations, parents are asked to check the temperature of their children prior to arriving on campus. If a child has a temperature of 100.4 or higher, please do not bring them to school. Do not medicate your child for a fever and bring them to campus. Additionally, please contact our office as soon as possible if your child has developed a fever while at home.
- Classrooms will be set up to promote physical distancing as much as possible.
- P.E. classes will be held outdoors (weather permitting).
